| School-Wide & Before / After School | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Polite language at all times • Be kind to everyone • Smile at others • Listen to adults | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be in proper place • Follow directions • Go directly to your destination | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be aware of surroundings • Walk from place to place • Stay on sidewalks when outside |
| Classroom | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raise hand to speak • Use inside voice • Keep hands/feet to yourself • Be polite to teacher and others | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In seat when bell rings • Be prepared to learn • Pay attention to teacher • Follow instructions | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remain seated • Use learning materials properly |
| Hallway & Lines | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walk • Stay in line • Use quiet voice • Hands at your side | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go directly to your destination • Only in hallway when instructed or with permission • Listen & follow directions | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Watch where you are going • Stay to right side of hallway • Do not follow too closely • Carry items safely |
| Cafeteria | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use good manners when eating • Say thank you and please to servers • Only eat your food • Listen to adults | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wait your turn in line • Keep food/drink in cafeteria • Pick up trash around you (even if not yours) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remain seated • Keep feet under table • Walk • Notify adult if you see food on the floor |
| Library & Computer Lab | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use quiet voice • Show care towards all materials • Be polite to library workers | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put books in proper place • Use equipment properly • Ask for help | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walk quietly • Sit properly at tables |
| Restroom & Locker Room | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give others privacy • Use quiet voice • Wait your turn | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flush toilets • Wash and dry hands • Trash in garbage can | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep water off of floor • Walk in and out • Report problems to adult |
| Bus | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow driver's instructions • Appropriate voice in conversation • Keep hands and feet to yourself | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be ready when bus arrives at your stop • Keep track of your stuff | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remain seated • No food or drink • Keep hands inside |
| Inside Recess | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be polite to others • Include others in games | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take care of games • Put games away when finished | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep hands/feet to self • No running |

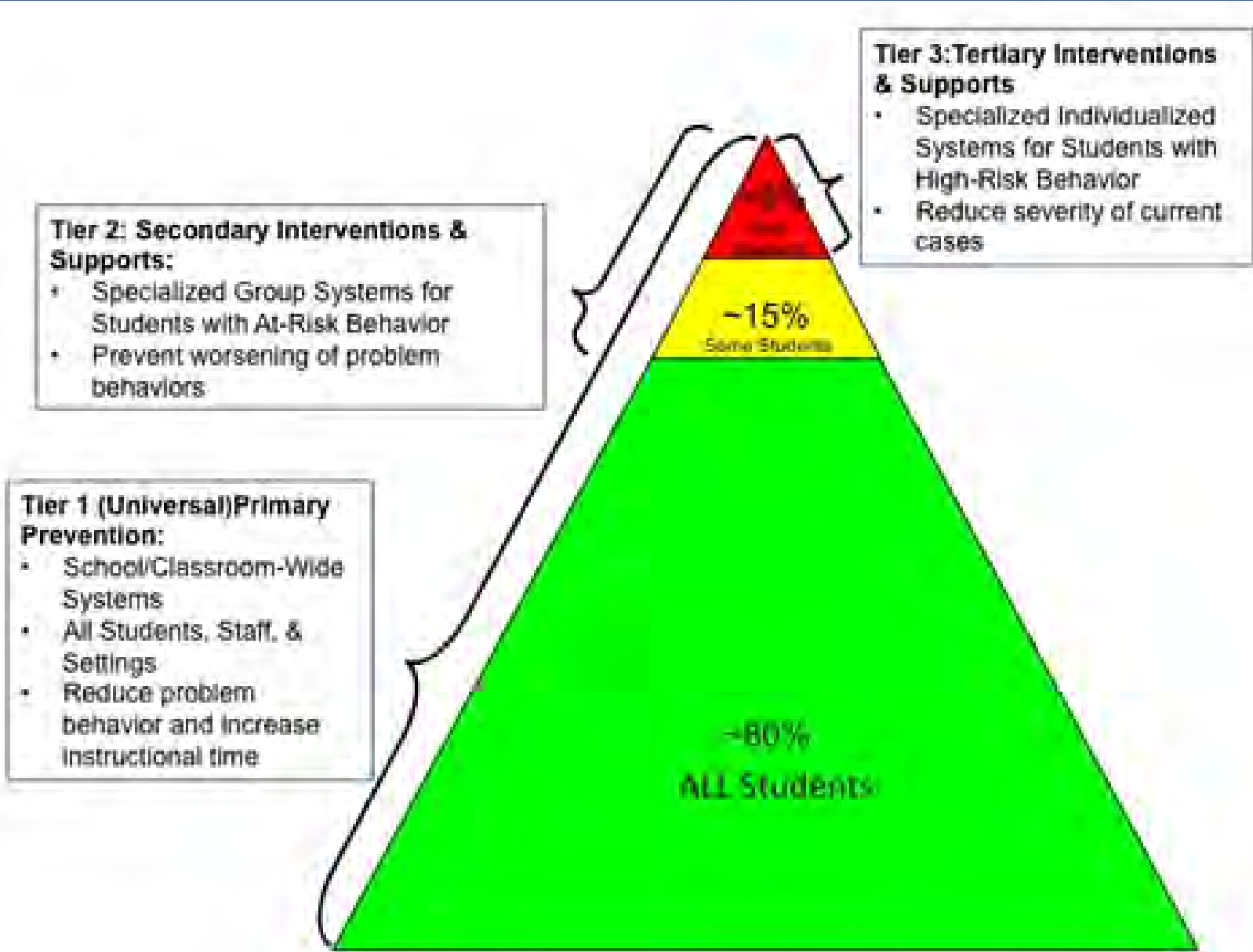
- Token Economy

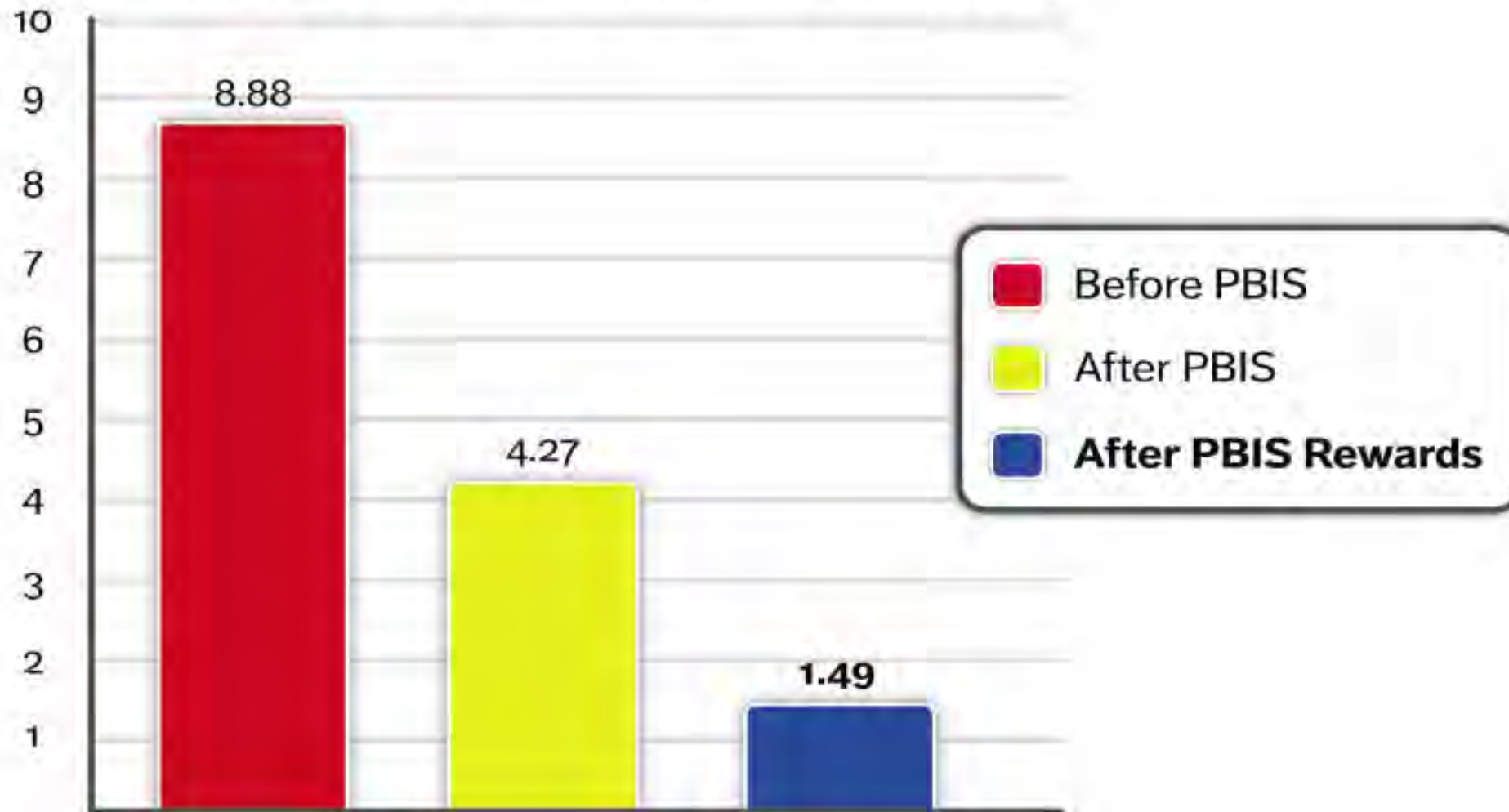


Tracking Progress
